2. MAKE FOOD FUN

Kids love to play make believe. Broccoli can be intimidating to a kid hoping for macaroni and cheese. But if he is a dinosaur who needs to eat five miniature trees in order to outrun a tyrannosaurus rex, suddenly those florets are a lot more interesting. Relating healthy food to fun things the child already loves and turning it into a game is a great way to get a few bites of greens down the hatch.

3. GET THEM INVOLVED

Children are more invested in a meal if they help with its preparation. Taking your kids with you to the farmer's market or grocery store and letting them pick one or two things to cook for dinner can make them far more exciting to eat it later. Better yet, start a garden and teach them how to plant and harvest their own. Letting them clean carrots, snap beans, mix the dressing and set the table gives them a sense of pride and makes them more enthusiastic and cooperative at meal time.
