#### MRS. WENDY GREVE RETIREMENT LUNCHEON




The retirement of Mrs. Wendy Greve, our middle

#### 11 PROVEN WAYS TO GET KIDS TO EAT MORE VEGETABLES

#### OFFER DIVERSE FOOD COLOR

One thing you have working in your favor is that children like colorful foods. You can expose them to more colors by adding more vegetables to their plates while adults tend to like flavors mingled together, children often prefer them separate. So you may have better luck making separate vegetable dishes instead of a big, mono-color casserole.

#### ARRANGE FOOD IN PATTERNS ON THE PLATE

Another reason to cook different vegetables separately is that children love when their food is designed into patterns on the plate. If you shape it into a heart or smiley face, they'll like it even more. This is another way to make food fun.
