## Early Pickup From School

Parents, be sure to notify both the receptionist office and your child's teacher in advance if you are picking up your child early from school. This helps your pickup run smoothly and gives us time to have your child in the office at the time you requested. ## Medications at School

If your child takes medication during the school day, please bring that medicine to the school office and complete a Medication Permission form. Children who keep inhalers in their backpacks should also have a Medication Permission form on file in the school office. All medicine must be in the original packaging and labeled with your child's name. If you think your child may need medicine for headaches or sore throats, please supply the office with the medication you wish your child to have. The school office does not keep any medication on hand to give your child. If your child has a headache or needs medication and we do not

have that medication from the parent, a call will be made to the parent to bring medication.

We will be switching from the summer to regular worship schedule on Sunday, September 8th. Sunday worship services will be 8:30 & 10:30am and will be in-person and online.
